Before being considered for a Grad Track Pathway, your graduate advisor and department chair or designee must sign and submit this form, along with the list of courses designated by the department to meet the minimum 3.50 GPA requirement (including final grade and GPA), to the Vice Provost of Graduate Education.

You must formally apply for admission to the master's program associated with the pathway. This requires submitting the application for admission so that the semester admit term for the master's degree immediately follows the semester that the bachelor's degree is awarded.
